The \$800 million New York State COVID-19 Pandemic Small Business Recovery Grant Program (the "Program") is now <u>open</u> for applications.

The Program was created to provide flexible grant assistance to currently viable small businesses, micro-businesses and for-profit independent arts and cultural organizations in the State of New York who have experienced economic hardship due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Businesses with gross revenues of \$25,000 - \$500,000 could receive a grant of \$5,000 - \$50,000.
